# What Happened | Doing It Better, EVERY TIME!



#### FIRES and STORMS

Trees down everywhere. No access to buildings. All tools were in "1 safe place" but now inaccessible!

Have critical tools & supplies where you can get to them accessible "safety sheds" in neighborhood.



#### ANIMAL WELFARE

Worried (frantic) about animals that couldn't be evacuated.

- **Have county Animal Hotline** numbers on phone, in emergency plan, a notebook, in your car.
- Call Animal Hotline to request help for animals as soon as you're in a safe place.
- Better prep for Animal SIP.



## **HAZARDS EVERYWHERE**

So many trees down, lots of debris to clear

Leave tools and ladders where firefighters can find & use.

Have supply cache with extra motor oil, axes, extra saw blades & chains.



#### JAMMED DOORS

Can't get to emergency supplies and go-bags.

**Keep bags & critical stay crates in** multiple locations, including car.



## **MORE PPE** (Personal Protection **Equipment)**

Include PPE for all kinds of hazard in buildings and out doors.

- Have PPE for everyone, plus extras.
- Include masks for protection from smoke & infection.
- Work gloves to prevent injury. Latex or Nitrile for Biosafety.
- Goggles, sunglasses, work boots, helmet, hard hat, layered clothing.



#### DEEP **SLEEPERS**

### **Could not rouse** family member!!

- Sign up for Alerts.
- Get NOAA radio with Pillow Shaker accessory.
- Use a whistle.
- Honk horns to wake neighbors.



## **EARTHQUAKE** / **LANDSLIDE**

Bridges, culverts, roads closed. Can't get out or in!

- Have backup power.
- Increase water storage.
- Staff & resources registered for Ag access.



#### PHONE NOT WORKING

No charge or reception, phone broken or lost

Have multiple ways to get info.

Local news radio, local HAMS. Keep contacts in phone and on paper.



#### **EVERYONE'S STRESSED**

Pets escaped from evac location.

Stress, fleas, sanitation = Health Challenges!

- Have "Pet Inside" signs in Go-Bag, updated photos and ID docs, and mirochip registration information.
- Have enough prescription meds & parasite control.
- Have sheets & towels for pet privacy, pet-safe cleaning supplies, baby wipes.
- NOTE TO SELF: BREATHE!!



## HARD TO LOCATE PROPERTY / LOCKED **DOORS & GATES**

Responders can't find or access property.

- Improve visibility, add reflective address signs, clear entrance, register gate code with Sheriff.
- House keys: Hide one, take one to Animal Control, if possible.



Flying objects blowing in blackout conditions.

Need goggles, helmets and headlamps handy



# **COMFORT**

Don't leave home without it - it will make you stronger!

Little luxuries make a big difference!

Fleece, neck pillow, Uggs, sleep mask, books, games - for you and your pets!
