Health and Safety Code section 41700 prohibits the discharge from any source whatsoever of quantities of air contaminants or other material that cause injury, detriment, nuisance, or annoyance to any considerable number of persons or to the public, or that endanger the comfort, repose, health, or safety of any of those persons or the public, or that cause, or have a natural tendency to cause, injury or damage to business or property. Health and Safety Code section 41701 prohibits the discharge into the atmosphere from any source whatsoever of any air contaminant, other than uncombined water vapor, for a period or periods aggregating more than three minutes in any one hour which is as dark or darker in shade as that designated as No. 2 on the Ringelmann Chart, as published by the United States Bureau of Mines.

## TOLLING AGREEMENT

It is further alleged as to Counts 6 to 33, that on September 25, 2020, the People and Defendant entered into a written agreement whereby Defendant knowingly, intelligently, and voluntarily waived any applicable statute of limitations defense for any criminal charges related to the Kincade Fire that might have expired on or about October 23, 2020, for a period of six (6) months, until April 23, 2021. In the written agreement, Defendant further acknowledged and agreed that it was to its benefit to waive any applicable statute of limitations defense, and that such waiver did not handicap its defense, and did not contravene public policy.
