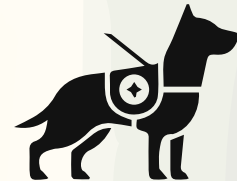

The Quarryhill Loop is an easy and relatively flat stroll by the Arbor created by the Garden's founder, Jane Davenport Jansen.

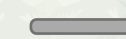


SERVICE ANIMALS ONLY

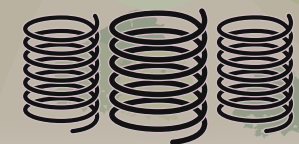
We share the Garden with rattlesnakes and mountain lions. For your safety, stay on the paths.
